**Title: Night Asleep Counselor**

**Current Location: Henry Lane Terrace**

**Current Shifts: 11 hour night shifts Sunday to Thursday (10 pm – 9 am)**

*Please note: All residential staff hours and location of work can be subject to change to meet the needs of the agency as determined by management. Some shifts may be up to 12 hours.*

**Start Date: As soon as possible**

**Wages:** Start rate \$ 19.16 per hour with legislated benefits.

**Duties:** To assist the Night (Awake) Residential Counsellor in providing supervision, care and developmental programming during the evening and morning hours for individuals with multiple disabilities in a residential setting. Act as a support to Night (Awake) staff by responding to emergencies, which may arise in resident care; and will assume the duties and responsibilities of the Night (Awake) staff in any location if required. Will assist with household upkeep during the morning hours and work as part of a team to provide supervision, and care (health, nutrition and hygiene).

**Required Qualifications:**

- Minimum of High School diploma and a Personal Support Worker diploma with specific knowledge of human development
- Completed Probationary period (**Probationary employees will only be considered if there are no other applicants**)
- Demonstrates a valued attitude toward individuals who are supported, congruent with social role valorization.

**Additional skills and experience that are an asset but not mandatory**

- Creative, energetic, able to solve problems, maintain positive attitude in busy environment.
- Has demonstrated good verbal and written communication skills in English, which is the working language at NVT.
- Knowledge of how to work with resident behavior protocols.
- Administration of enteral nutrition and medication
- Willingness to learn new tasks i.e. administration of meals through G-tubes aero-chamber, suctioning machine, Bipap, oximeter and oxygen
- Use of the ceiling lift
- Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively with families and co-workers
